

HOW TO ROLL OR FOLD A QUILT FOR GIFT GIVING



1. Lay your quilt on a table with backing facing up.



2. Fold top left corner down toward you.



3. Fold the quilt by bringing top edge toward you. This determines the height of the roll. Adjust number of folds as needed. (See next photo.)



4. Re-folded into thirds so the roll will be shorter.



5. Flip the entire quilt over (Notice the binding is now on the far side.)



6. Start rolling from the right side.



7. Rolling completed.



8. Tuck end into the diagonal fold to secure.

HOW TO FOLD A QUILT FOR GIFT GIVING – METHOD 2 (for larger quilts)



1. Lay your quilt out lengthwise
With backing facing up.



2. Fold both left and right sides in
an equal distance. The binding should
not quite meet the edge.



3. Now fold the bottom up.
(Slightly more than 1/4th
the length.)



4. Fold the top edge of the quilt down twice.



5. Grab the very top folded edge and fold down again.
This time, tucking it into the opening in bottom section.
Smooth the tucked-in section so that it lies flat.



6. Your quilt is now ready for gift giving with all the edges neatly tucked in.
